**Airport** – Kelowna International Airport is located in the north end of Kelowna, approximately 12 kilometers (7.3 miles) from the show hall and 3.70 kms (2.3 miles) to the show hotel. Sorry, the club is unable to offer transportation. Kelowna Shuttle meets all flights until 10:45pm 7 days per week. Rate is \$12.00 to the show hotel and \$19.00. to the other hotels with a reduction for multiple persons.

**TICA's Hotel Room Inspection Policy** – The TICA official hotel room inspection procedures **may** be used at all listed hotels. Whole males & spraying females **must** be confined to the bathroom. **Do not** rinse out litter boxes in the hotel room sinks or tubs. Take extra care for cleanliness and neatness of your rooms at all hotels, so that their facilities will be available for us in future years. Exhibitors that do not abide by these guidelines will not be allowed to attend future shows. Any damage done to any hotel room will be the responsibility of the exhibitor and not the Okanagan Valley Cat Fanciers. The condition of your room reflects on the entire Cat Fancy, and it only takes one mishap to lose a hotel.

**Show Hours** – Saturday the doors will open at 7:30 am. Exhibitors must check in with the Entry Clerk prior to entering the show hall. Household Pet classification will begin at 8:30 am Saturday and judging will start promptly at 9:00 am. Sunday judging will begin at 9:00 am. Entries not present at the start of judging will be marked absent. No cat will be allowed to leave the show hall, during advertised show hours, without permission of the show manager. Advertised hours for the public will be from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm both days.

**Show Hall** – The show will be held at the Parkinson Recreation Centre located at 1800 Parkinson Way, Kelowna, BC. The show hall is wheelchair accessible. Ample free parking is available at the show hall. This is a non-smoking show hall. Show hall transportation is not provided so please make your own arrangements.

**Vendors & Advertising** – Vendor space is available at a charge of **\$100 for a 10 ft. x 6 ft.** booth with one eight foot table and 2 chairs for both days of the show. Contact Beth Ritland at (250) 868-1616 or [ritland@shaw.ca](mailto:ritland@shaw.ca). Advertising rates are as listed on the summary sheet and must be camera ready.

**People Food** – Catered by Deli City Catering/Bunches Bistro. Outside food or alcohol **not** permitted in the show hall.

**Judges Dinner** – Saturday Oct 9 at 7 pm at The Kelowna Yacht Club 1414 Water Street. Full Buffet with no host bar. Space is limited so prepay on the summary sheet.

**Cat Food & Litter** – Cat litter will be provided in the show hall. Bring your own cat food, dishes and litter pans.

**Ring Clerks & Stewards** – If you would like to clerk, please indicate this on the Summary Sheet. Clerks will receive lunch, plus \$40 for each full day of clerking. Clerks will be paid after clerking; please do not deduct clerking fees from your entry form. Preference will be given to those in the clerking program.

Please indicate on the Summary Sheet if you have a child who would like to steward. Stewards will receive lunch, plus \$20 for each full day of stewarding.

**Benching** – A single cage is 21” x 21” x 21”. A double cage is 21” x 21” x 45”. The top, floor, sides and back of the cage must be covered. One cat or two kittens are allowed in a single cage. Two cats or four kittens are allowed in a double cage. Each entry is entitled to a single cage. *If you use your own personal cage you must purchase adequate spacing.* Benching requests must be clearly indicated on the **summary** sheet.

No benching assignments may be changed without the permission of the show committee. Vending from the benching area is prohibited.

**Exhibition/For Sale** – Single and double cages are available for exhibition and for sale entries. An official TICA entry form must be completed for each cat or kitten in the show hall. All cats and kittens in the show hall must be listed in the official show catalogue, as per TICA show rule 211.9. Kittens must be three months of age on or before the day of the show (born on or before July 9, 2010). Litter registration may be required by the show committee for “on exhibition” or “for sale” kittens.

**Health** – This is a non-vetted show. Every cat that enters the show hall must conform to normally accepted health requirements and be up-to-date on its vaccinations. Proof of vaccination may be requested, please have certificates on hand. Cats from households with contagious or infectious illnesses within the last 21 days are ineligible for entry. **Cats**

***with suspected contagious or infectious illness or with parasites will be removed from the show hall.*** All claws, front and back, must be clipped.

Cats over 3 months of age entering Canada must show proof of current Rabies vaccination, if requested to do so by Canada Customs and the Canada Food Inspection Agency (CFIA). Customs agents and CFIA do not require a Health Certificate, but if the cat is traveling into Canada by air, the commercial airline may require a health certificate. Contact your airline for more information on their requirements.

**Household Pets** – Household Pets over 8 months of age must be altered (neutered or spayed). Household Pets from 4 to 8 months old are entered in the Household Pet Kitten class and can be either altered or unaltered. Household Pets are judged according to hair length (longhair or shorthair) and according to colour & division. Please describe your cat's colour and coat pattern accurately and note whether it is longhair (LH) or shorthair (SH) on your entry form. A colour photo mailed with your entry will be returned to you at check in. Please telephone the entry clerk if you are not sure how to describe your cat's colour and coat pattern or if you have any questions about how to complete the entry form.

**Kittens** – Must be 4 calendar months old (not sixteen weeks of age) to compete in the show. For this show, kittens must be born on or before June 9, 2010.

**Closing Dates, Payments and Fees** – See Summary Sheet for information on entry fees

- Closing date to be in the catalogue is September 30, 2010 or when 125 paid entries are received. Confirmation of your entry into the show will be confirmed via email when payment is received. Remember to check your confirmation as soon as you receive it.
- Closing date for receipt of early bird entries and payment is September 8th, 2010. Late entries will be changed to Regular and you will need to pay the additional at the gate.
- All entries must be accompanied by a money order preferably or a personal cheque payable to the Okanagan Valley Cat Fanciers. Upon entering, exhibitors agree to pay all fees due even if they fail to bench.
- Cats co-owned by members of two different households are eligible for the 'second entry' and 'third and subsequent entries' discount ONLY if a photocopy of the cat's TICA registration accompanies the cat's entry. The registration must show the names of both co-owners.
- No postdated cheques will be accepted.
- A fee of \$30 will be added to your entry fees for any cheque returned for non-sufficient funds. Money orders eliminate the possibility of this additional charge.
- There will be a \$10 substitution fee and no substitutions will be allowed once the show is closed.
- A \$12 surcharge will apply on all phoned in entries.

**Show Catalogues** – One show catalogue is included with your first entry. Additional catalogues must be ordered on your summary sheet for \$10 each. No catalogues will be available for sale at the show hall. The show committee accepts no responsibility for catalogue errors due to illegibility or mistakes on the entry form. Please check your confirmation when you receive it. This is exactly how your entry will appear in the show catalogue. Inform the entry clerk of any errors on the confirmation immediately.

**Preliminary New Breeds & Advanced New Breeds** – According to TICA Show Rule 203.19, all Preliminary New Breeds (PNB) and Advanced New Breeds (ANB) must have a TICA registration number prior to entering any TICA show, No PNB or ANB may enter a show with "registration pending".

**Registration** – With the exception of Korats, registration with TICA is not necessary to compete in the cat's first show, but is required for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and subsequent show and for confirmation of championship titles and TICA regional and international awards. Contact TICA for specific registration procedures.

**Show Rules** – This cat show is sanctioned by The International Cat Association (TICA) and is subject to their Show Rules and Breed Standards. The Show Rules and Breed Standards are available from the TICA Executive Office, PO Box 2684, Harlingen TX, 78551, and (956) 428-8046 or posted on the TICA website [www.tica.org](http://www.tica.org). By entering, all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the Show Committee and Judges.

**Liability** – The Okanagan Valley Cat Fanciers, its individual members, the Parkinson Recreational Centre, and TICA will not be held responsible for injury, loss or damage to cats, exhibitors, vendors or other persons attending the show, or any property belonging to exhibitors, vendors or other persons.
