Closing Date:

We will take entries up to midnight on Saturday 19th February 2015 or when hall is full Date de cloture dimanche 19 février 2015

Official show times 2pm Friday, 0900 – 1700 Sat and Sun Heures du show 2pm Vendredi, Samedi & Dimanche 09h00 – 17h00

Entry Fees

- 1 day £50 for first cat in a double space (metal pen extra) £45 for additional cats
- 2 days £88 for first cat in a double space (metal pen extra) £79 for additional cats
- 3 days £99 for first cat in a double space (metal pen extra) this equals to £33 per day!! £89 for additional cats

Double Metal pens £10 each for 1, 2 or 3 days

Two cats for all 3 days in <u>their own pen</u> - one space £160 Three cats for all 3 days in <u>their own pens</u> - two spaces £230; Ask if you want to bring more than three. Offers <u>MUST</u> be <u>paid</u> by <u>1st January 2015</u> or the special fees will not apply and normal fees will be due.

PAYMENT ON THE DOOR <u>MUST</u> BE ARRANGED IN ADVANCED WITH THE ENTRY CLERK AND BE PAID IN STERLING (GBP) CASH AND WILL INCUR A £6 SURCHARGE. IF AN ARRANGEMENT IS NOT MADE IN WRITING WITH THE ENTRY CLERK, TARDY TURTLE OF £15 PER CAT PER DAY WILL BE ADDED IN ADDITION TO THE £6 SURCHARGE.

Check In:

Friday 13:00 to 13:45, Saturday and Sunday 08:00-08.30am all exhibitors must check in, present vaccination cards and collect catalogue. You should check in all days so we can compile the absence list.

Judging starts 2pm Friday, 9.00am Saturday and Sunday



Confirmations

Please enclose SAE for confirmation with entry only if you have not supplied an email address. It is your responsibility to ensure you have received a confirmation, if you have not received a confirmation please call the entry clerk **before** the closing date of show

Cages:

Benching will be in traditional rows, The club will provide double bench spaces as standard. Double metal pens can be hired at ± 10 each for 1, 2 or 3 days.

Supplies:

Please bring your own litter/trays/cat food/water/dishes and bedding. Forgotten items will be available for purchase from vendors but choice may be limited. Cage Drapes are optional. Waste bins will be provided but please do not put soiled litter in the bin as this smells and is not nice to clear up or be near; bring bags with you to put the soiled litter in. Please do not drop litter around your pen, or shake out your sturdi etc. on the floor. Some people leave their space in a very bad state, would you do this at home?? The area around your pen should be left as you find it. I cannot stress how important it is to keep the Leisure centres on side.

Friendly Reminder:

Please leave the hotel room in the condition you found it and put all cat litter in trash bags, open windows or put air sprays around. The condition of your hotel room reflects on the entire cat fancy. Cat friendly hotels are becoming rare. Please don't let us lose another one.

Health:

This is a non-vetted show. All cats should be in date for vaccinations with Feline Enteritis and cat flu, records must be produced at check in. Any cat showing signs of illness, disease, fleas, fungus or mites will have to leave the show hall. ALL CLAWS MUST BE CLIPPED BEFORE CHECKING IN. Remember they do have four legs!! Any obviously pregnant or lactating cat will be disqualified.



People Food:

There is a catering outlet upstairs from the show hall, which will be open and serving hot/cold food from 8am-3pm both days

Household Pets:

If unsure of colour/pattern send a picture with your entry and it will be returned. If your cat has a bushy tail then it should be entered as a longhair! Household pet adults must have been neutered/Altered.

Clerks & Stewards:

We need both! Please indicate on the entry form which day(s) you are available to help make this show an outstanding success. Clerks will receive £25 per day, free lunch. Stewards will receive £10 and a free lunch. (Please volunteer early for these essential jobs.)

New Exhibitors:

Registration:

All cats in New Traits, Prelimary New Breeds & Advanced New Breed classes much be registered with TICA in order to be shown.

Transport: The nearest airport is either Heathrow or Gatwick. The Channel Tunnel is only one hour by car via the M20. Regrettably neither the club nor the Hotel can provide transport.
