

**Kittens:** Kittens entered in the show must be at least 4 calendar months but less than 8 months of age on the day of the show. Altered kittens are eligible for entry.

**Household Pets:** HHP over 8 months of age must be spayed or neutered. HHP are Judged in all rings. In order to claim titles, regional and international awards they must be registered with TICA.

**Registration:** With exception of Korats and New Breeds, registration with TICA is not necessary to compete for a cats' first show, but is required for confirmation of titles and scoring for the TICA regional and international awards.

**Transport:** The nearest airport is either Heathrow or Gatwick. The Channel Tunnel is only one hour by car via the M20. Regrettably neither the club or the Hotel cannot provide transport.

**Liability:** TickedTICA Cat Club and White Oak Leisure Centre will not be held liable of injury, loss or damage to cats, kittens, Exhibitors, spectators or property of exhibitors, spectators or Vendors or other such person or property in attendance.

### Confirmations

Please enclose SAE for confirmation with entry only if you have not supplied an email address. It is your responsibility to ensure you have received a confirmation, if you have not received a confirmation please call the entry clerk before the closing date of show.

### Benching

The club will provide **single pens** (2ftx2ftx2ft) as standard. Two cats from the same household will be penned together in a double pen unless otherwise stated. Benching will be traditional rows; requests for benching preference should be submitted with entry. No cats or kittens will be offered for sale in the show hall. Litter bins will be provided. Exhibitors should bring their own litter trays, litter, water, cat food, dishes and cage drapes (optional). Exhibitors may provide a suitable pen (such as a sturdy pen) please indicate this on the entry form.

### Health Requirements

This is a vetted show. Cats showing signs of illness, mites, fleas or fungal infection will not be permitted to the show hall. All cats should be in date for vaccinations with Feline Enteritis and cat flu. Records must be produced at vetting in. Cats from households where there has been an infectious disease or fungal infection within 21 days of the first day of the show are ineligible for entry. Any cat pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. All claws front and back must be clipped.

Official TICA Entry form may be down loaded from the TICA site.

### Show Rules:

TICA Show Rules will be strictly enforced. Rosettes will be awarded in accordance with these rules. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the Judges and Show Committee.
